OTHER RESTRICTIONS: All waters of Totten Inlet southwest of a line running northwest from the northern tip of Burns Point through the double pilings north of the Olympia Oyster Company building to the shore are Closed (Kennedy Creek closure). **All waters of Skookum Inlet are CLOSED.** Beach Seines: **Release all Coho**

JUSTIFICATION: COMMERCIAL HARVEST OF CHUM SALMON. This fishery will target chum salmon destined for adjacent inlets and will be managed according to escapement requirements of the chum stocks intercepted.
