OTHER RESTRICTIONS: Drift and Set Net hours are 4pm to 9am daily, All waters of Totten Inlet southwest of a line running northwest from the northern tip of Burns Point through the double pilings north of the Olympia Oyster Company building to the shore are Closed (Kennedy Creek closure). All waters of Skookum Inlet are CLOSED.

JUSTIFICATION: COMMERCIAL HARVEST OF CHUM SALMON. This fishery will target chum salmon destined for adjacent inlets and will be managed according to escapement requirements of the chum stocks intercepted.
